Fr. Brian called the monthly Vestry Meeting to order with prayer.

**Minutes** – After reviewing the April minutes, Katie Gardner moved, seconded by Jane Montgomery, to approve the minutes as presented. Vote: unanimous.

**Sr. Warden** – No report.

**Jr. Warden** – David Crouch reviewed the list of building maintenance projects to be completed, which includes gutter replacement, landscaping, and steps at the altar. Kyle is getting estimates for the gutters. Pete Montgomery and Fr. Brian will get bids for landscaping. Parish workday was scheduled for Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM – noon. The date will be announced in the newsletter. Inside and outside tasks include organizing the kitchen pantry, parish hall and closet cleaning, vacuuming and wiping down the pews in the sanctuary, window washing and power washing pavers.

**Christian Ed** – Katie reported that she attended a session based on Mother Theresa’s book, “No Greater Love”. She will attend two more sessions this month. A class is being offered to congregations that need to form an action plan in the instance of an active shooter. Fr. Brian, Carl Schultz, Jane and Katie will attend.

**Worship** - A COVID Guideline update from the Bishop is expected by June 1st. Policies will be communicated to the Vestry prior to going out to the congregation. The choir will sing this Sunday.

**Rector Report** – Fr. Brian reported that his sabbatical has been funded through a grant from the Diocese. He has met with Fr. Jim and he is onboard. Bill Bryant will also be asked to assist. Fr. Brian met with Keisha Mallette regarding the need for an Emergency Response Plan in the event of a flood, hurricane, freeze, etc. David Crouch agreed to be on the committee.

**New Business** –Will noted that during the Columbarium formation one of the thoughts was to create a labyrinth or prayer garden in the seating area. We will keep this in mind for the future. Our internet connection was lost midway through last Sunday’s service. David will test a back-up and report at our next meeting.

**Old Business** – Only 2 responded to the request for help with the community garden. It was suggested that the League City Garden Club be asked for assistance. They declined. As a result, the garden will be decommissioned and the area will be repurposed for future needs.

**Treasurer’s Report** – Eric Zapp reviewed the Treasurer’s Report. The PPE loan has been forgiven, which will increase our income and reduce our liability.
